Recently, he argued and won Indiana's seminal case on aviation noise and inverse condemnation in the Indiana Supreme Court. *Biddle v. Indianapolis Airport Authority et. al.*, 860 N.E.2d 570 (Ind. 2007). Mr. Alexander's practice additionally focuses on business and complex litigation, with an emphasis on contractual disputes, business separation litigation, trade secret violations, inverse condemnation claims, covenant-not-to-compete enforcement, and other general litigation. He is a graduate of Wabash College, B.A., 1989 (*summa cum laude*, Phi Beta Kappa) and Indiana University School of Law, J.D., 1992 (*summa cum laude*, *Indiana Law Review*).
