

2022 Ohio Election Recap


Statewide Race Results

- Mike Dewine wins re-election in the Ohio Governor's race over Nan Whaley (62.79 percent)
- Dave Yost wins the Attorney General race over Jeff Crossman (60.37 percent)
- Keith Faber takes the Auditor's race over Taylor Sappington (58.98 percent)
- Frank LaRose will continue as Secretary of State, defeating Chelsea Clark (D) and Terpsehore
 Maras (I) (59.54 percent)
- Robert Sprague won the Treasurer's race over Scott Schertzer (58.78 percent)
- JD Vance will be the next Senator, replacing retiring Senator Rob Portman

Ohio Statehouse Update

House

- Republicans are poised to expand their House majority by 4 to 68 to 31, with a the biggest surprise win by Republican Nick Santucci in traditionally Democratic Trumbull County.
- Of note presumed candidate for Ohio House Speaker, Derek Merrin, won a tight Toledo area race that was considered a tossup.

Senate

- Republicans picked up one seat with Michelle Reynolds, defeating incumbent Democrat Senator Tina Maharath to give them a super majority of 26-7.
- Senator Matt Huffman (R-Lima) will remain Senate President in the next General Assembly.

There are now 25 Republicans and 7 Democrats in the Senate.
 In the House, 64 Republicans and 30 Democrats.

Republicans swept all of the Ohio Supreme Court Races, including the election of new Chief Justice Sharon Kennedy.
